Because education is power, the Tulsa Chapter Board of Directors is excited to introduce **EduPower**! All you have to do is actively participate in Chapter activities and accumulate as many points as you can. This opportunity is *in addition* to your ability to make application for available scholarships to Regional or National Conferences.

You will have two chances to win: Points accumulated April 1st through August 31st will be considered for a scholarship toward the Region 4 Conference; points accumulated September 1st through March 31st will be considered for scholarship toward the National Conference. The scholarship award includes reimbursement of: early-bird registration and one-night's lodging (pro-rata) at the designated ALA conference hotel(s).

Here are the point values. The member with the most points wins!

- 2 points – submit an article for publication in The Legal Pad
- 2 points – attendance at Legal Expo
- 3 points – active participation on any committee
(cannot be combined with “Chair” points for same committee)
- 3 points – sponsoring a new member (active recruitment, other than by committee chair)
- 3 points – participation in Community Challenge Weekend (CCW) activity
- 3 points – attendance at monthly Chapter meetings
- 5 points – committee chair (cannot be combined with “committee” points for same committee)
- 5 points – service on the Tulsa Chapter Board
- 5 points – mentoring a new member (with "regular" contact over a six-month period)
- 5 points – presenting an educational session to the Chapter
- 5 points – service on any regional or national committee or board (through ALA or FALA).

The purpose of **EduPower** is to provide an additional opportunity to take advantage of the excellent education your professional association offers; to have some fun; to get you involved in YOUR Chapter and to reward the member who puts forth the most effort.

EduPower Scholarship Guidelines:

The two members with the highest accumulated points are first in place for consideration. The Scholarship Committee tallies the points and announces same by email shortly after the accumulation period closes. The member with the highest points will have one week to accept the scholarship before it is offered to the member with the second highest points. If both members have equal points each will be asked to submit a short essay/application which will help the Scholarship Committee better define the merit of each applicant.

Upon award notification, the member ("Member") should immediately advise the Scholarship Committee regarding acceptance/declination of award. If Member receives reimbursement for any of the conference costs from a source other than the local Chapter, the Scholarship Committee may consider reimbursing other conference expenses (i.e., lodging, food, travel, etc.) in an amount up to the eligible scholarship amount. In the event Member does not need the entire awarded amount, the Scholarship Committee may, in its discretion award the remaining specific scholarship funds to the member with the next highest points. If the member with the highest points declines the scholarship, the scholarship will continue to roll down to the member with the next highest number of points until awarded.

Once accepted, should Member's circumstances prohibit Conference attendance the award shall revert to the Scholarship Committee for further consideration.
